Thriving by Three Infant and Toddler Child Care Grants

Family Child Care Providers

Thriving By Three Act (Bill S2476)

Purpose:

- Incentivize the expansion of capacity for infants and toddlers
- Provide technical assistance to child care providers
- Address shortages in infant and toddler care capacity
- Support the developmental needs of young children



Overview

• DFD is offering the grant to address shortages of high-quality child care for infants/toddlers and to support the developmental needs of young children.

Slots must be maintained for the duration of the 3-year grant period.



Family Child Care Eligibility Summary

Eligible programs must:

- Comply with state and federal health and safety requirements for family child care providers.
- Comply with current family child care licensing standards for infant and toddler child care, including, but not limited to, childto-staff ratios and health and safety standards.
- Be in good standing (no enforcement action or fraud and/or funding misrepresentation investigation or misuse of funds).



Family Child Care Eligibility Summary Cont.

Eligible programs must:

- Use the funds to develop or expand quality child care spaces for infants/toddlers.
- Participate or apply to participate in the state's child care quality rating and improvement system, Grow NJ Kids, no later than twelve (12) months after initial grant approval.



Priority for Grant Award Selection

Preference will be given to providers and programs that are:

- Located in communities with few or no options for high-quality child care for infants and toddlers;
- Located in communities with a high percentage of low-income families;
- Able to demonstrate need to increase and fill slots; and
- Committed to quality.



Year 1 Initial Grant Award Amount

- Initial minimum grant award of \$3,000 per new infant or toddler child care slot created.
- \$1,000 must be provided to a caregiver, either the alternate provider, substitute or assistant as required to meet child/staff ratios.
- If not already enrolled in, or rated by, Grow NJ Kids, providers must enroll within twelve (12) months of initial grant award.
- This initial award is available to all eligible providers.



Year 2 Renewal

- Year 2 award will be paid approximately 12 months following the date of the initial grant award
- To receive the Year 2 award, the provider must have:
 - Completed a Needs Assessment (a CCR&R Infant/Toddler Specialist will contact the provider to complete this assessment)*; and
 - Be enrolled and actively engaged in Grow NJ Kids.

*Based on the results of the Needs Assessment, family child care providers may be eligible to receive up to \$1,200 in additional infant/toddler-related supplies/equipment/materials to address health and safety violations and/or to support program quality. The Grow NJ Kids Technical Assistance Center for your region will purchase and distribute these supplies to eligible providers.



Year 2 Grant Award Amount

- Providers who have not yet reached a Grow NJ Kids rating of 3, 4 or 5 stars at the start of Year 2 will receive an additional grant award of \$1,200 per new infant or toddler slot.
 - \$400 of this amount must be directed for staff, as required to meet child/staff ratios under 3A:54-6.2 of the Manual of Requirements for Family Child Care Registration.
- If you are already rated 3, 4 or 5 stars in Grow NJ Kids at the start of Year 2 you are not eligible for the \$1,200 per slot grant award, however, you are eligible to receive \$300 per newly created and enrolled slot.



Year 3 Renewal

- Year 3 award will be paid approximately 12 months following the date of the Year 2 grant award.
- During Year 3, the provider must:
 - Complete a Grow NJ Kids Self-Assessment;
 - Complete a Grow NJ Kids Quality Improvement Plan;
 - Submit a Grow NJ Kids Rating Readiness form to initiate the rating process;
 and
 - Have all newly created infant/toddler slots filled by the end of the 3rd year



Year 3 Grant Award Amount

- Providers who have not yet reached a Grow NJ Kids rating of 3, 4 or 5 stars at the start of Year 3 will receive an additional grant award of \$1,200 per new infant or toddler slot.
 - \$400 of this amount must be directed for staff, as required to meet child/staff ratios under 3A:54-6.2 of the Manual of Requirements for Family Child Care Registration.
- If you are already rated 3, 4 or 5 stars in Grow NJ Kids at the start of Year 3 you are not eligible for the \$1,200 per slot grant award, however, you are eligible to receive \$300 per newly created and enrolled slot.



Approved Uses of Grant Funds

Thriving by Three Infant and Toddler Child Care Grant funds may be spent in the following approved categories:

- Equipment/furniture
- Materials/Toys/Supplies
- Staff/Recruitment/Hiring
- Other Needs (e.g., professional development, technical assistance, etc.



How Do I Apply?

Grant application will be available in NJCCIS beginning November 1!

Log in to your NJCCIS account and navigate to the Grants tab from your Quicklinks panel



Application

- The application will take approximately 15 minutes to complete.
- You do not have to complete the application in one session.

Information you will need to complete the application:

- Full and part-time enrollment information
- Infant/toddler waitlist information (if applicable)
- Infant/toddler rate information (F/T and P/T rates)
- Assistant/alternate/substitute hourly wage rate information



Application Status

- You will be notified via email when a decision has been made regarding your Thriving by Three (TBT) Infant and Toddler Child Care Grant application, or whether any additional information is required.
- Grant awards will be based on available funding.
- You can also check the status of your application at any time in the Grants section of your Quicklinks panel. If your application is approved, you can use the "View" button to see information regarding your grant award amount and payment date.

Family Child Care Provider \$1,000 Referral Award

- The \$1,000 Family Child Care Provider Referral Award is separate from the Thriving by Three Grant award.
- Current family child care providers may refer a person who would like to become a new registered family child care provider.
- Current family child care providers will submit a completed Family
 Child Care Provider Referral Award Application Form to their
 county's Child Care Resource and Referral (CCR&R) agency.



Family Child Care Provider \$1,000 Referral Award

• Once the new provider completes the registration process, the referring provider will receive an award of \$1,000.

- Payment will be issued by the CCR&R:
 - Providers who are participating in the Child Care Assistance Program will be paid through EPPIC.
 - Providers who are not participating in the Child Care Assistance Program will be paid by check.


2023 Market Rate Survey
