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Child Care Development Block Grant (CCDBG) Funding Announcement Infant Expansion Quality Initiative Grant

The New Jersey Department of Human Services, Division of Family (DHS/DFD), is making grants available to support programs participating in the state's Child Care Subsidy Program to comply with the Child Care Development Block Grant (CCDBG) Reauthorization Act requirements. One of these grants include a specific emphasis on increasing licensed child care centers' capacity to serve infants.

The Infant Expansion Quality Initiative Grant is designed to increase access to high quality infant child care programs in underserved areas (high demand for infant care). The grant will provide a monthly rate of \$100* **above the base subsidy rate** per infant enrolled, beginning December 2018, for a one-year period of service. There are two types of Infant Expansion Quality Grants available – Infant Expansion and New Infant Slots.

Eligibility Criteria

Infant Expansion: Licensed child care centers that are committed to quality care (enrolled, but not rated, or enrolling in Grow NJ Kids) who are interested in increasing or expanding their infant capacity in underserved communities of high demand for infant care.

New Infant Slots: Licensed child care centers that are committed to quality care (enrolled, but not rated, or enrolling in Grow NJ Kids) who are not currently serving infants of families who are receiving a subsidy but are interested in doing so.

To be considered for this grant, programs must serve families receiving a subsidy, or commit to accepting infants receiving subsidy, if applying for the infant expansion grant. Grants are based on available funds and released by priority.

General Requirements

- All grants are subject to the requirements of the CCDBG and Child Care Development Fund (CCDF)
 Program.
- These grants are available to eligible programs (meeting health and safety requirements) participating
 or interested in serving families and children in the NJ Child Care Subsidy Program and have not had a
 serious injury or death occur due to a substantiated health or safety violation as of March 2018.
- Programs interested in applying for any of the grants below must submit an application with the required documents.
- All grants are subject to an application review process and may require a site visit.

These funds are limited, therefore applications will not be accepted beyond November 2019 or when all the funds have been spent, whichever comes first. All programs must commit to immediately participate and achieve a three (3) star or higher quality rating status through the Grow NJ Kids program.

^{*}The additional \$100 monthly rate per new infant is intended as a bridge until the center becomes fully rated by Grow NJ Kids and is eligible for new enhanced rates under the Grow NJ Kids program.
