

Instructions on how to sign up and complete the New Jersey Child Care Subsidy Health and Safety Trainings

All required training information and links can be found on www.ChildCareNJ.gov/Providers/Training

Please note: Only the health and safety training courses linked to below or the courses offered through your CCR&Rs will be counted towards your required training hours for DFD’s Subsidy Assistance Program Health and Safety Requirements.

You can go directly to the online course through this link – https://od.bkc.psu.edu/user/sign_in

This will take you to the sign in screen. If you already have an account, enter your email address and select the option for “Yes, I have a password.” Enter your password and click “Continue”.

If you do not already have an account, you will need to create one. Enter your email address and select the option for “No, I am a new customer.” Then click “Continue”. There will be several pages of profile questions. You must fill these out completely.

When you have successfully created your profile, you will end up back at the log in page where it will say **“Your registration was successful. You may now Sign In with your email address and password.”**


Enter your email address and select the option for “Yes, I have a password.” Enter your password and click “Continue”.

PLEASE NOTE:
If you have a NJ Workforce Registry ID, please make sure to enter that information when creating your account.

If you signed up and did not enter your NJ Workforce Registry ID into your profile, you can do so at any time by clicking on the “Profile” link under “Your Account” in the left navigation bar after logging in. Once on the “Better Kid Care Profile” page, click continue through the screens until you get to the “Do you participate in NJ Workforce Registry” page. Select “Yes” and click “Continue”. You can then enter your NJ Workforce Registry ID. If you need help finding your ID, instructions can be found under the Bookmarks section of www.njccis.com.

Certificate data is provided to the NJ Workforce Registry on a bi-monthly basis. Your certificate completion information will not automatically appear in your NJ Workforce Registry account. **NOTE:** Your NJ Workforce Registry ID # is 9 digits and starts with 100 (for example: 100123456). Your last name must match in both your Better Kid Care and NJ Workforce Registry accounts. If they do not match then your certificate data will not appear in your NJ Workforce Registry account.

Description All child care professionals are responsible to keep the children in their care healthy and safe. This eight-hour module provides an overview of nine of the required health and safety topics plus basic child development information for the Child Care and Development Block Grant (CCDBG). Completion of this module fulfills the New Jersey requirement for six hours of CCDBG Health and Safety plus two hours of child development training.

Best practices and standards for health and safety and knowledge of typical child development are the foundations of quality child care. Meeting the basic health and safety needs of all children and use of knowledge of individual children to provide appropriate environments, experiences, and interactions set the stage for positive child outcomes.

This module provides an overview of basic health and safety and child development requirements and best practices in ten of the topic areas outlined in the Child Care and Development Block Grant (CCDBG) Reauthorization of 2015.

- Safe spaces
- Transportation safety
- Handling and storage of hazardous materials
- Emergency preparedness
- Prevention and control of infectious disease
- Food and allergic reactions and how to respond
- Administration of medication
- Shaken baby syndrome/abusive head trauma
- Safe sleep and SUIDS prevention
- Foundations of child development
